Welcome to Cataloochee Ski Area! Please see the pass options below for both Weekday and Weekend/Holiday rates. **Reserve tickets online up to 14 days in advance.** After tickets are selected, rental equipment may be added to your cart.

Once tickets are reserved, they can be easily printed at the Ski Area on the day of your reservation. The kiosks for printing passes are located in the lower level of the Main Lodge. Tickets may also be printed at the ticket window outside of the Main Lodge by a Guest Service Representative who can assist with Group or Private lessons as well.

After getting your tickets printed and rentals fit, take your time getting yourself and family together, there's no rush. Enjoy a meal at Cat Café or take in the scenery on our viewing deck. There is no appointed time for your day ticket to begin (beginning & ending of ticket must be within our hours of operation). On-snow time only begins when you enter the slopes, then continues until the end of your 4 or 6 hour slope ticket. Night tickets only begin at 5pm and continue to close.

Weekends/Holidays \$37 per person for 1hr 45min session

Reserve tickets online up to 2 weeks in advance. Sessions are one hour and 45 minutes long and run every two hours. There is a 42" minimum height requirement. Only Tube World equipment may be used. No two person tubing allowed.
